3. Hazard identification

Irritating to eyes, respiratory system and skin.
Additional labelling: Careful, not fully tested compound.

4. First aid measures

After inhalation: Fresh air, in case of respiratory problems seek medical advice.

After skin contact: Wash off with plenty of water, soap or other suitable cleaning agents. Remove contaminated clothing.

After eye contact: Rinse out with plenty of water with the eyelid held wide open. Call in ophthalmologist. After ingestion: Make victim drink plenty of water, induce vomiting. Seek medical advice.

5. Fire fighting measures

Suitable extinguishing media: CO2 (carbon dioxide), water spray, dry chemical powder, or appropriate foam. Special risk: Combustible. Ambient fire may liberate hazardous vapours.

Special protective equipment for fire fighting: Do not stay in dangerous zone without self-contained breathing apparatus.

Other information: Prevent fire-fighting water from entering surface water or groundwater.

6. Accidental release measures

Person-related precautionary measures: Avoid substance contact. Avoid generation of dusts; do not inhale dusts. Environmental-protection measures: Do not allow to enter sewerage system.

Procedures for cleaning / absorption. Take up dry and forward for disposal. Clean up affected area.

7. Handling and storage

Handling: Protect from light.

Storage: Keep container tightly closed. Dry. Protected form light. At +15° C to +25° C.

8. Exposure controls/personal protection

Personal protective equipment:

Protective clothing should be selected specifically for the working place, depending on concentration and quantity of the hazardous substances handled. The resistance of the protective clothing to chemicals should be ascertained with the respective supplier.

Respiratory protection: Required when dusts are generated, filter P2.
